

Welcome and registration form for new members of BC Kimbria

Dear prospective member,

Welcome to BC Kimbria! We love to welcome you and would like to invite you to participate in a total of **three** trial training sessions. After that, if you decide you like it and would like to join the club, your team coach will give you a link to a registration form.

Once you have filled it out and sent it in (or have your parents do that for you), your registration will be processed as soon as possible and you will be a member of BC Kimbria and pay membership fees. We will also register you with the Dutch Basketball Federation (NBB).

* Expectations

As a club, we have a number of expectations for <u>all our members</u>. We also expect a number of things from the parents of or youth members. This means more than just training and playing, or just dropping off and picking up your child at training sessions and games. The aim is to have a club where everyone is involved, feels safe and has the opportunity to play fun basketball and have a good time, and performs a number of tasks to achieve that.

We expect the following from our members and/or parents:

- 1. **Being involved** in the club and **read** what is communicated by the board (especially in the newsletters and on the website);
- 2. Fulfilling a number of **tasks** (referee duties, jury duties, team parents, washing services of uniforms, driving to away games etc.) per season;
- 3. **Participating** in courses to fulfil those duties (referee courses, jury courses, trainers' breakfast session, etc.);
- 4. Creating a safe, inclusive and supportive **atmosphere** within your team and the club;
- 5. Ensuring that all club **materials** are set up neatly before the game and are stored properly and safely after the game. We are careful with our equipment!

* Club fees



Club fees are collected once a year, for the entire season. This takes place at the beginning of each season. In exceptional cases, payment schemes can be made, in consultation with the treasurer.

We want everyone to be able to play sports at Kimbria, regardless of their financial situation. So ask the Sportfonds (Koninklijke Sportfondsen) about the possibilities.

The NBB association fees (see below) are collected separately.

The fees consist of:

- 1. The club contribution (facilitating trainers, renting the halls, etc.).
- 2. The association fees (for competition members; this is determined by the association).
- 3. Uniform rental (for league playing members).

* Rules of conduct

BC Kimbria has a policy and some rules of conduct - you can find them here [BEING DEVELOPED]. <u>All</u> members must abide by these. These rules are about behaviour on and off the court, as well as sportsmanship, inclusiveness, safety, respect for each other and all other types of behaviour that should be expected of members in social settings.

Failure to follow these rules can result in warnings and possibly even expulsion from the club. So please read these carefully and abide by them!
